

# **Bharat Skill Development Centre (BSDC)**

## **Community Medical Services & Essential Drugs (CMS & ED) Legal & Compliance Policy**

### **1. Course Nature**

Community Medical Services & Essential Drugs (CMS & ED) is a Skill Development and Healthcare Training Programme intended to provide knowledge in community health, first aid, health awareness, essential medicines concepts, disease prevention, and basic healthcare support.

### **2. Recognition**

This programme is conducted under BSDC's education and skill development framework. It is not represented as equivalent to MBBS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BDS, B.Sc. Nursing, or any statutory medical qualification.

### **3. No Medical Licence**

Completion of this programme does not make a student a Registered Medical Practitioner (RMP), MBBS doctor, or confer an automatic legal right to independently practice Modern Medicine (Allopathy) or prescribe medicines where prohibited by law.

### **4. Scope of Training**

Training may include Community Health Awareness, First Aid, Basic Health Education, Hygiene & Sanitation, Nutrition, Maternal & Child Health Awareness, WHO Essential Medicines concepts, Referral System, and Health Record Maintenance.

### **5. State Laws**

Students must comply with the applicable laws, government notifications, court decisions, and registration requirements of the State/Union Territory in which they reside or work.

### **6. Student Declaration**

The student acknowledges the limitations of this programme and agrees not to misrepresent the certificate as a medical licence or claim to be an MBBS doctor or Registered Medical Practitioner unless legally authorized.

### **7. Institutional Disclaimer**

BSDC does not encourage or authorize unlawful medical practice. Any misuse of the certificate, false representation, or violation of applicable laws shall be the sole responsibility of the individual.

### **8. Certificate Usage**

The certificate is evidence of successful completion of a training programme only. It is not a medical registration or licence to practice medicine.
